Romans 6:4b (NLT) 4b And just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glorious power of the Father, now we also may live new lives.

Romans 6:5 (NLT)

5 Since we have been united with him in his death, we will also be raised to life as he was.

Romans 6:6a (NLT) 6a We know that our old sinful selves were crucified with Christ so that sin might lose its power in our lives.

Romans 6:6b (NLT) 6b We are no longer slaves to sin.

Romans 6:7 (NLT)

7 For when we died with Christ we were set free from the power of sin.
