### Truth: There are certain things that block people from pursuing the Kingdom and living a fruitful life for Jesus.



Matthew 13:3 (NLT) 3 He told many stories in the form of parables, such as this one: "Listen! A farmer went out to plant some seeds.

### <u>Matthew 13:4 (NLT)</u> 4 As he scattered them across his field, some seeds fell on a footpath, and the birds came and ate them.

Matthew 13:5 (NLT) 5 Other seeds fell on shallow soil with underlying rock. The seeds sprouted quickly because the soil was shallow.

Matthew 13:6 (NLT) 6 But the plants soon wilted under the hot sun, and since they didn't have deep roots, they died.

### Matthew 13:7 (NLT) 7 Other seeds fell among thorns that grew up and choked out the tender plants.

Matthew 13:8 (NLT) 8 Still other seeds fell on fertile soil, and they produced a crop that was thirty, sixty, and even a hundred times as much as had been planted!



### Matthew 13:18 (NLT) 18 "Now listen to the explanation of the parable about the farmer planting seeds:

Matthew 13:19a (NLT) 19a The seed that fell on the footpath represents those who hear the message about the Kingdom and don't understand it.

### Matthew 13:19b (NLT) 19b Then the evil one comes and snatches away the seed that was planted in their hearts.

Matthew 13:20 (NLT) 20 The seed on the rocky soil represents those who hear the message and immediately receive it with joy.

Matthew 13:21 (NLT) 21 But since they don't have deep roots, they don't last long. They fall away as soon as they have problems or are persecuted for believing God's word.
