

I. Prepare Wisely for <u>Persecution</u> before Jesus Returns.

1 Thessalonians 2:2a (NLT) You know how badly we had been treated at Philippi just before we came to you and how much we suffered there.

<u>1 Thessalonians 2:2b (NLT)</u> Yet our God gave us the courage to declare his Good News to you boldly, in spite of great opposition.



II. Prepare Wisely by <u>Making</u> <u>Changes</u> Now to Follow Jesus.

<u>1 Thessalonians 2:11 (NLT)</u> And you know that we treated each of you as a father treats his own children.

1 Thessalonians 2:12 (NLT) We pleaded with you, encouraged you, and urged you to live your lives in a way that God would consider worthy. For he called you to share in his kingdom and glory.



III. Prepare Wisely for Daily <u>Warfare</u> Against Your Enemies.

<u>1 Thessalonians 2:18 (NLT)</u> We wanted very much to come to you, and I, Paul, tried again and again, but Satan prevented us.

1 Thessalonians 2:19 (NLT) After all, what gives us hope and joy, and what will be our proud reward and crown as we stand before our Lord Jesus when he returns? It is you!

<u>1 Thessalonians 2:20 (NLT)</u> Yes, you are our pride and joy.
