# Big Idea: Strong faith in Christ delivers us through suffering (not from suffering).

### 1 Thessalonians 3:4 (NLT) 4 Even while we were with you, we warned you that troubles would soon come—and they did, as you well know.

### 1 Thessalonians 3:5a (NLT) 5 That is why, when I could bear it no longer, I sent Timothy to find out whether your faith was still strong.

# 1 Thessalonians 3:5b (NLT) I was afraid that the tempter had gotten the best of you and that our work had been useless.

For you have been given not only the privilege of trusting in Christ but also the privilege of suffering for him.

#### 1 Peter 4:12 (NLT)

Dear friends, don't be surprised at the fiery trials you are going through, as if something strange were happening to you.

### James 1:2 (NLT)

Dear brothers and sisters, when troubles of any kind come your way, consider it an opportunity for great joy.

# James 1:3 (NLT) For you know that when your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow.

#### James 1:4 (NLT)

So let it grow, for when your endurance is fully developed, you will be perfect and complete, needing nothing.

1 Thessalonians 3:6b (NLT) He reports that you always remember our visit with joy and that you want to see us as much as we want to see you.

1 Thessalonians 3:7 (NLT) So we have been greatly encouraged in the midst of our troubles and suffering, dear brothers and sisters, because you have remained strong in your faith.

1 Thessalonians 3:8 (NLT) It gives us new life to know that you are standing firm in the Lord. 9 How we thank God for you! Because of you we have great joy as we enter God's presence.

#### 1 Thessalonians 3:12 (NLT) And may the Lord make your love for one another and for all people grow and overflow, just as our love for you overflows.

1 Thessalonians 3:13 (NLT) May he, as a result, make your hearts strong, blameless, and holy as you stand before God our Father when our Lord Jesus comes again with all his holy people. Amen.
