1 Thessalonians 4:13 (NLT) And now, dear brothers and sisters, we want you to know what will happen to the believers who have died so you will not grieve like people who have no hope.

1 Thessalonians 4:14 (NLT) since we believe that Jesus of

For since we believe that Jesus died and was raised to life again, we also believe that when Jesus returns, God will bring back with him the believers who have died.

1 Thessalonians 4:15 (NLT) We tell you this directly from the Lord: We who are still living when the Lord returns will not meet him ahead of those who have died.

1 Thessalonians 4:16a (NLT) For the Lord himself will come down from heaven with a commanding shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trumpet call of God.

1 Thessalonians 4:16b (NLT) First, the believers who have died will rise from their graves.

1 Thessalonians 4:17a (NLT) Then, together with them, we who are still alive and remain on the earth will be caught up in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air.

1 Thessalonians 4:17b (NLT) Then we will be with the Lord forever.

1 Thessalonians 4:18 (NLT) So encourage each other with these words.

1 Thessalonians 4:16a (NLT) For the Lord himself will come down from heaven with a commanding shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trumpet call of God.

When everything is ready, I will come and get you, so that you will always be with me where I am.

What will happen when Jesus returns? 2. No one knows the exact day or time when Jesus will return.

Mark 13:32 (NLT)

"However, no one knows the day or hour when these things will happen, not even the angels in heaven or the Son himself. Only the Father knows.

Mark 13:33 (NLT)

And since you don't know when that time will come, be on guard! Stay alert!

What will happen when Jesus returns? 3. The Bible lists <u>signs</u> that will <u>precede</u> Jesus' return.

1 Thessalonians 5:1 (NLT) Now concerning how and when all this will happen, dear brothers and sisters, we don't really need to write

1 Thessalonians 5:2 (NLT) For you know quite well that the day of the Lord's return will come unexpectedly, like a thief in the night.


1 Thessalonians 5:3a (NLT)

When people are saying, "Everything is peaceful and secure," then disaster will fall on them as suddenly as a pregnant woman's labor pains begin.

1 Thessalonians 5:3b (NLT) And there will be no escape.

1 Thessalonians 5:4 (NLT) But you aren't in the dark about these things, dear brothers and sisters, and you won't be surprised when the day of the Lord comes like a thief.

Matthew 24:28 (NLT) Just as the gathering of vultures shows there is a carcass nearby, so these signs indicate that the end is near.



What will happen when Jesus returns? 4. When Jesus returns:

4. When Jesus returns: The bodies of those who have died in Christ will be resurrected and joined with their spirits.

1 Thessalonians 4:14 (NLT) since we believe that Jesus of

2 Corinthians 5:8 (NLT)

Yes, we are fully confident, and we would rather be away from these earthly bodies, for then we will be at home with the Lord.

Luke 23:43 (NLT) And Jesus replied, "I assure you, today you will be with me in paradise."

4. When Jesus returns: Unbelievers will be <u>judged</u> by Jesus and be sentenced to eternity in <u>hell</u>.

John 5:28 (NLT)

Don't be so surprised! Indeed, the time is coming when all the dead in their graves will hear the voice of God's Son,

John 5:29 (NLT) and they will rise again. Those who have done good will rise to experience eternal life, and those who have continued in evil will rise to experience judgment.

4. When Jesus returns: Believers in Jesus will be given glorified bodies.

1 Corinthians 15:42 (NLT) It is the same way with the resurrection of the dead. Our earthly bodies are planted in the ground when we die, but they will be raised to live forever.

1 Corinthians 15:43 (NLT)

Our bodies are buried in brokenness, but they will be raised in glory. They are buried in weakness, but they will be raised in strength.

1 Corinthians 15:44 (NLT) They are buried as natural human bodies, but they will be raised as spiritual bodies. For just as there are natural bodies, there are also spiritual bodies.

4. When Jesus returns: Believers will be rewarded according to their good works.

Revelation 11:18 (NLT)

...It is time... to reward your servants the prophets, as well as your holy people, and all who fear your name, from the least to the greatest...


4. When Jesus returns: Believers will begin eternity in the presence of God in heaven.




What will happen when Jesus returns? 5. Christians <u>differ</u> over exactly how Jesus' <u>return</u> will take place.




1. Amillennialism. The first view to be explained here, amillennialism, is really the simplest.



2. Postmillennialism. The prefix post-means "after." Christ will return after the millennium.




3. Premillennialism. The prefix pre- means "before," and the "premillennial" position says that Christ will come back before the millennium.




*Classical Premillennialists differ over whether the renewed earth will begin in the millennium or the eternal state.

4. Premillennialism. The prefix pre- means "before," and the "premillennial" position says that Christ will come back before the millennium and tribulation.



1 Thessalonians 4:17a (NLT) Then, together with them, we who are still alive and remain on the earth will be caught up in the clouds to meet the Lord in the air.

1 Thessalonians 4:17b (NLT) Then we will be with the Lord forever.



Matthew 24:42 (NLT)

"So you, too, must keep watch! For you don't know what day your Lord is coming.

Matthew 24:43 (NLT) Understand this: If a homeowner knew exactly when a burglar was coming, he would keep watch and not permit his house to be broken

into.

Matthew 24:44 (NLT) You also must be ready all the time, for the Son of Man will come when least expected.

Our response to the reality that Jesus is returning: 2. Invest in eternity.

Matthew 6:19 (NLT)

"Don't store up treasures here on earth, where moths eat them and rust destroys them, and where thieves break in and steal.

Matthew 6:20 (NLT) Store your treasures in heaven, where moths and rust cannot destroy, and thieves do not break in and steal.

Our response to the reality that Jesus is returning: 3. Be His witnesses.

Acts 1:6 (NLT)

So when the apostles were with Jesus, they kept asking him, "Lord, has the time come for you to free Israel and restore our kingdom?"

Acts 1:7 (NLT)

He replied, "The Father alone has the authority to set those dates and times, and they are not for you to know.

Acts 1:8a (NLT) But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you.

Acts 1:8b (NLT)

And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

Acts 1:9 (NLT)

After saying this, he was taken up into a cloud while they were watching, and they could no longer see him.


Acts 1:10 (NLT)

As they strained to see him rising into heaven, two white-robed men suddenly stood among them.

Acts 1:11a (NLT) "Men of Galilee," they said, "why are you standing here staring into heaven?

Acts 1:11b (NLT)

Jesus has been taken from you into heaven, but someday he will return from heaven in the same way you saw him go!"
