





Love Lesson #1 (Kindergarten):

Learn to Obey Authority.







Ephesians 5:21-24 (NLT) And further, submit to one another out of reverence for Christ. For wives, this means submit to your husbands as to the Lord. For a husband is the head of his wife as **Christ is the head of the church. He is the Savior of his** body, the church. As the church submits to Christ, so you wives should submit to your husbands in everything.











For Husbands:

Your role is to lead your wife as you obey the authority of Jesus.









Your role is to follow the leadership of your husband just like you follow the authority of



Jesus.









1 Peter 3:1-2 (NLT) In the same way, you wives must accept the authority of your husbands. Then, even if some refuse to obey the Good News, your godly lives will speak to them without any words. They will be won over by observing your pure and reverent lives.









Love Lesson #2 (Grade School):

Learn to Sacrifice for One Another.







Ephesians 5:25-27 (NLT) For husbands, this means love your wives, just as Christ loved the church. He gave up his life for her to make her holy and clean, washed by the cleansing of God's word. He did this to present her to himself as a glorious church without a spot or wrinkle or any other blemish. Instead,

she will be holy and without fault.









Love Lesson #3 (Jr. High):

Learn to Selflessly Serve One Another







Ephesians 5:28-30 (NLT) In the same way, husbands ought to love their wives as they love their own bodies. For a man who loves his wife actually shows love for himself. No one hates his own body but feeds and cares for it, just as Christ cares for the church. And we are members of his body.









Love Lesson #4 (High School):

Learn to Suffer Together.

Ephesians 5:31 (NLT) As the Scriptures say, "A man leaves his father and mother and is joined to his wife, and the two are united

Love Lesson #5 (Graduation):
